

Design for stitch - Textured surfaces

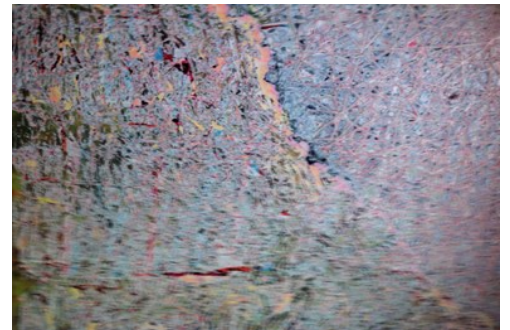

Create exciting surfaces with colour and texture that will inspire stitching. The more designs suggest stitching the easier it is to make the transition into textile. Make textures using a variety of papers with mixed media methods. We will explore painting, scraping, sponging, crumpling, resists, adding tissue paper, painted bondaweb, taking out colour and adding it back in with oil crayons and inks.

Please bring:

Several sheets of cartridge paper, tissue, brown paper, Acrylic paints, oil crayons, water soluble crayons, brushes, water pot, palette, small piece of sponge. Roll of kitchen paper, an apron and disposable gloves.

If you have them bring gesso, texture gels, wax crayons, aqua wax, inks, painted Bondaweb.
