

Introduction to English Paper Piecing a Pin Cushion

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We all remember piecing hexagons together as a child. Now the technique, know as English Paper Piecing, has been brought right up to date, using many more different shapes that interlink making the most of wonderful bright fabrics. It's a great introduction to Patchwork. But be warned - its addictive!

Please bring the following;

Fabric. Preferably cotton. Either 2 fabrics that go together or scraps. If you are buying for the class, 2 fat quarters are more than enough.

Stuffing

Scissors - fabric and paper

Sewing thread to match

Needles - ideally sharps size 9 or 10

Thimble if you use one

2 buttons at least 1/2" or 1.5cm

You will be given patterns and paper shapes for both pincushions.

Don't worry if you don't have something from the list. Most items will be available from Workaid stocks at a nominal cost.
